We have had a very busy but exciting week. This week the children have been exploring 2D shapes in maths and we have been looking at the artist Kandinsky. The children have produced fantastic art work which is displayed in our classroom. In phonics, the children are working really hard and we have been focusing on reading and writing our tricky words, please continue to do this at home.
