
Expressive arts and design

Read through

Afterwards Mary and Joseph took Jesus home to Nazareth.

Answer the questions:

Why did Mary and Joseph take Jesus to the Temple?

Who were the people that they met?

Why did Simeon and Anna go to the Temple?

Why do you think Simeon and Anna were so pleased to meet Jesus?

What did Mary and Joseph do after they left the Temple?

Activity: Can you make cardboard candles with tissue paper flames. Ask children what did Simeon say about Jesus? (Jesus is the light of the world).
